Course structure

Each programme consists of 180 credits and follows the same structure:

- 60 credits of compulsory modules: these are specialist modules to deepen knowledge chosen area
- 60 credits of optional modules: broaden knowledge and tailor your course to your interests.
- 60 credits for research and dissertation project: these compulsory modules develop skills and allow to explore an area of interest in detail

MA Global Political Economy


Key themes:

A firm grounding in the key **theories and concepts** of global political economy, their application to contemporary challenges, global power structures and inequalities

Analytical investigation of **capitalism in practice** how sectors, markets and firms interact in foundational sectors such as food, health, pharma, water, to understand how key debates around work, poverty, climate change, technology inform everyday experience and protest

The exploration of the **frontiers of political economy** through discussion of major innovative works in neighbouring disciplines that opens up new analytical boundaries in political economy

An in-depth exploration of the global political economy of **money, debt and finance**, the regional and global inequalities and crises that they produce and the historical and social dynamics that sustain them.

MA International Relations

Key themes:

This programme will shape your understanding of international relations by examining a wide range of advanced theories, approaches, and stimulating debates in the complex field of international politics and relations.

You will analyse topics central to the functioning of the **international system** and explore contemporary and historical approaches, focusing on country-specific, regional and international processes. This programme takes an interdisciplinary approach and reflects the broadening nature of international relations beyond the confines of inter-state relationships.

You will have the opportunity to develop expertise in a specialist area of interest to you, whilst working with leaders in the field of international relations. As well as enhancing your knowledge in international relations and the complex and contradictory forces that shape the global agenda, this programme will equip you with excellent research skills, and develop your knowledge of relevant methodologies and approaches.

MSc Political Science

Core modules provide a set of widely applicable skills in place of subject-specific knowledge:

- Survey design → design surveys and survey experiments
 - Program surveys using Qualtrics (widely used survey creation tool)
- Text analysis → gather and analyse text-based data (e.g., newspapers, social media)
 - Automate data collection & analysis with Python (common programming language for webscraping)
- Network analysis → graphically analyse the connections between groups, people, or ideas
- Statistical analysis → use regression analyses to empirically analyse large quantitative datasets
- Research design → put your data collection and analysis skills together to examine some of the many economic, social, and political challenges facing our societies

Fees and Scholarships

Application process

Apply through our **Applicant Portal** – open now for 2026 entry. Entry requirements:

- Undergraduate Bachelors degree in a related subject area with a 2:1 result (Taiwanese equivalency of at least 75%). Lower degree results may be considered in combination with relevant practical experience.
- Pass all elements of the first semester at NTPU.
- English language requirements, e.g.: IELTS 6.5 overall, with no less than 6.0 in each component. Other tests are also accepted, and we also offer preparatory, pre-sessional programmes (6 or 10 week) both in person and online, from our Language Centre.

The earlier NTPU students apply, the better. Please include these documents:

- Copy of original degree certificate and transcripts + a certified translation if not in English
- Transcript showing marks to date from NTPU (if possible). Identify your study at NTPU on your application form
- CV/resume
- Personal Statements and References are not required
- Deadline to apply: 31 July 2026 (but the accommodation guarantee is on 1st July!)

How to apply to other Masters courses

Academic background requirements can vary – but a 2:1 (UK) equivalent is required, which is usually at least 75% in a Taiwanese Bachelors degree

We accept a range of English language qualifications:

- IELTS 6.5 with no less than 6.0 in each component.
- TOEFL 88 overall with no less than 19 in listening, 20 in reading, 22 in speaking and 21 in writing.
- PTE at 64 overall with no less than 60 in any component.
- Leeds summer pre-sessionals are available at our Language Centre (6 week or 10 week).
- 6 week or 10 week pre-sessional *online* with our Language Centre
- Other English tests are accepted.

Pre-sessional courses

Our pre-sessional courses are tailored to students preparing for:

- undergraduate study
- Masters courses
- postgraduate research (ie: PhD)

We offer:

- Pre-sessional courses during the academic year
- 10 and 6 week summer pre-sessional courses
- 10 week and 6 week online summer pre-sessional course

Students can study pre-sessional courses for up to a full year (two semesters plus summer) with start dates in October, January, and July.

Why study a pre-sessional?

If English isn't your first language, studying a pre-sessional course at Leeds will help you to:

- Improve your academic English level to the standard needed for your academic course.




